Son de San Diego plays music from the southern region of Veracruz State in Mexico known as Son Jarocho. They use traditional stringed instruments (*jarana*, *guitarra de son* and *tarima*). The best-known song from this tradition is “La Bamba.” The director, Eduardo Garcia teaches in the Visual and Performing Arts Department at California State University San Marcos.
