Indonesian Encounters 2012

Arrive Denpasar, Bali: Before June 25, transfer to Flower Mountain.

Bali Workshop: Monday, June 25 through Sunday, July 8, daily classes in Javanese, Sundanese, and Balinese music, dance, and puppetry. Introduction to Indonesian language. Special events and guests.

Payangan Festival: Friday, July 6 through Sunday July 8. Balinese music, dance, and theater from Payangan village and other areas of Bali.

Java Tour and Introduction to Javanese Arts (Tentative): July 9-July 15.

Departure to Yogyakarta, Central Java: Monday, July 9, on Garuda Indonesia Airlines

Mon. Check into Manohara Hotel (Borobudur).

Tue. Sunrise visit to Borobudur stupa, tour with a leading guide. Lunch buffet in Yogyakarta. Shopping on Jalan Malioboro.

Wed. Morning dance rehearsal at Mangkunegaran (10:00-12:00 A.M.). Lunch in Solo. Transfer to Hotel in Solo. Visit town of Wonogiri, dinner and wayang kulit puppet performance at home of dalang P. Midiyanto.

Thu. Morning visit to Kraton Solo and Pasar Klewer. Lunch at Solo Inn. Afternoon visit to Prambanan temple complex en route to early check-in at hotel in Yogyakarta, or optional afternoon visit to other ancient temples in the area, together with evening dinner and performance of Ramayana Ballet at Prambanan.

Fri. Morning visit to batik shops. Imogiri (1:00-4:00) & Parangtritis Beach. Dinner and klenengan at Bapak Djoko Walujo's home.

Sat. Day-long excursion to Dieng Plateau. All night wayang at Kraton Jogja.

Sun. Visit Kraton Jogja, see royal dance performance in the morning. Return to Bali on Garuda and check in at Flower Mountain.

Fees and Program Coverage

Cost for the 3-week Indonesian Encounters is \$1,995 per person

Cost for the 2-week Bali Workshop is \$1,295 per person

Cost for the 1-week Java Tour is \$795 per person

What is included:

- Room and board (two weeks) at Flower Mountain, Payangan, Bali
- Tuition for all officially scheduled group classes at Flower Mountain
- Entrance to the Payangan Festival in Bali and all performances in Java
- Regional air, round trip Bali/Yogyakarta, Central Java
- Demonstrations and hands-on experience with gamelan, dance, & puppetry
- All hotels and breakfasts in Java
- Daily transportation in Java for scheduled group events

What costs are not included:

- International airfare (\$1,200-\$1,500)
- Connecting domestic transportation to and from international flights
- Visa-on-Arrival (\$25)
- Transportation to and from airport in Bali (up to \$25 per transfer)
- Indonesian airport departure tax (\$15)
- Local transport in Bali, other than organized tours
- Laundry & extra beverages (alcoholic, juice, soft drinks, etc.)
- Lunches and dinners in Java (\$6-\$10 per meal)
- Entrance fees to optional tourist performances in Ubud, Bali (\$8 per event)
- Private lessons with workshop faculty (\$15 per hour)
- Workshop staff group tip
- Extra days at Flower Mountain (\$20 per day)
